The Redstone Arsenal Chapter of the US Army Warrant Officer Association (RSA-USAWOA) is pleased to offer the RSA-USAWOA Annual Scholarship Program. The goal of the program is to make financial awards to the most deserving candidate without putting undue emphasis on any particular aspect of the eligibility and application process. Decisions are made by a committee and are based on the whole person concept.

Throughout the year, our Chapter conducts various fundraising events. Substantial portions of the proceeds are set aside for this scholarship program. From these funds, RSA-USAWOA will award a minimum of one \$1,000.00 scholarship to a deserving and qualified applicant(s). Application packets must be received prior to May 14, 2010 in order to be considered. Completed application packets should be mailed directly to:

Applications will be accepted from the children, adopted children, dependant stepchildren, or the spouse of a Sponsor. A Sponsor is on Active Duty, in the Reserves, in the National Guard, is Retired Military, or is a current DOD Civilian. The Applicant or Sponsor must permanently reside in the Tennessee Valley Region of the State of Alabama.

An applicant who is a child, adopted child, or dependant stepchild of a qualifying person must be 20 years of age or younger and must be a Senior in High School or a currently-enrolled College Freshmen. Child applicants must receive more than half of their support from the Sponsor to be eligible. Applicants who are spouses of Sponsors must be enrolled as a college Freshman or Sophomore.

All applicants must plan to attend, or continue their education, in an accredited American college/university, or vocational technical institution on a full time basis.

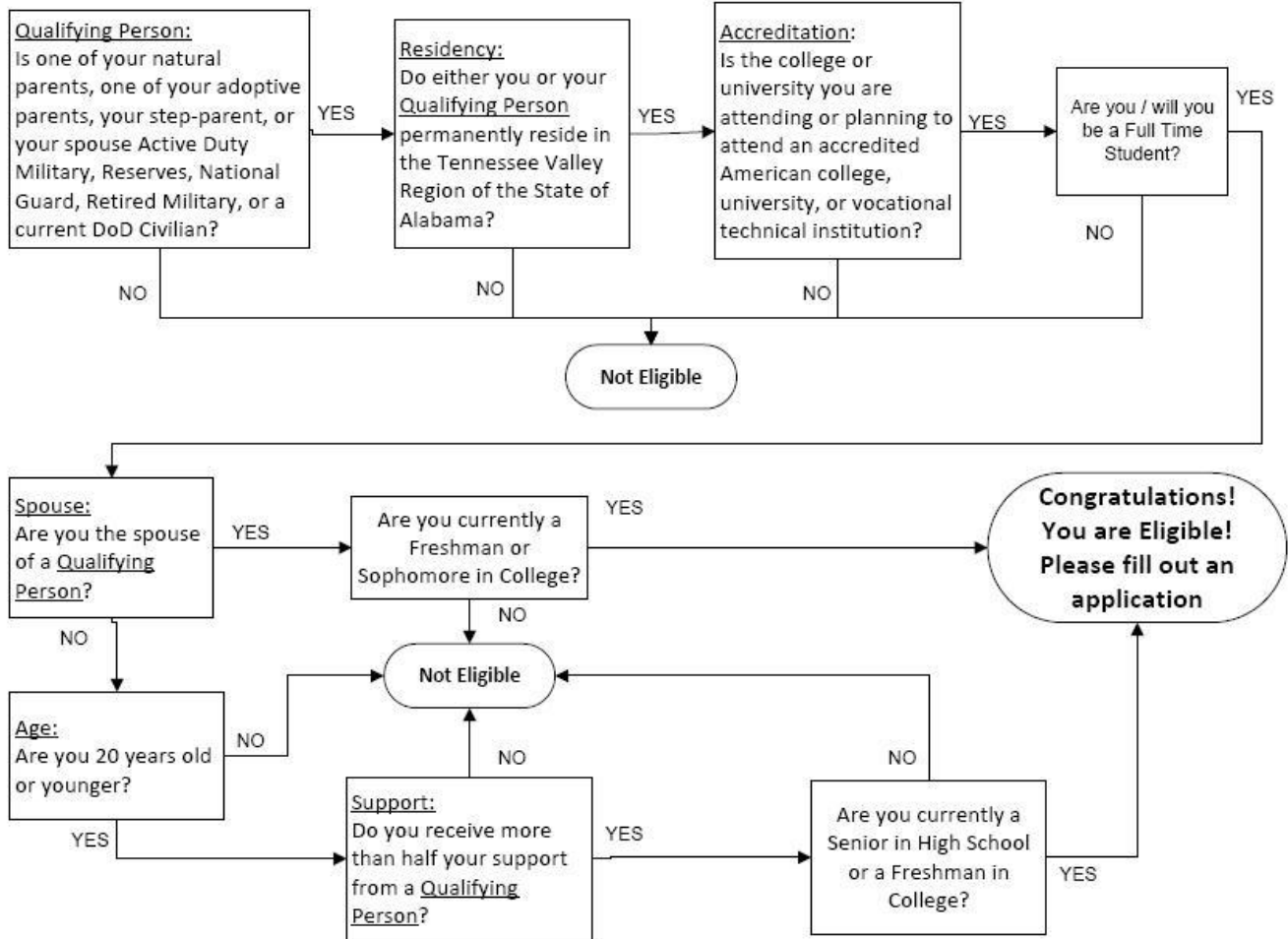
The application packet must consist of:

1. Basic Application form.
2. A typewritten essay describing the educational goals of the applicant, and any Volunteer work being performed for the community (150 – 600 words).
3. Recommendation from high school counselor, instructor, or current faculty advisor if already attending college or trade school. Nontraditional students will need a recommendation from a current/former faculty advisor.
4. Official High School (and college if applicable) transcripts showing a minimum grade point average of 2.5.
5. National Test Scores (i.e., SAT, ACT, etc.).

Applications must be complete at the time of receipt. No "partial" applications will be accepted. All applications must be received prior to May 14, 2010 to be considered. Awards will be announced by June 9, 2010. Awardee(s) will be personally contacted.

Scholarship distribution will be made upon receipt of correspondence from the school Registrar confirming registration. Checks will be made out to the school and will be sent to the student's designated financial aid office.
